Allergy Care/Immunology: Consultations and treatments for allergies and asthma, along with medical treatment that helps your body fight off diseases, are provided at our treatment center.

Cardiology (Heart Care): Nationally recognized by the Intersocietal Accreditation Commission (IAC), our Cardiology Department does work in several areas of echocardiology and nuclear stress testing. Our skilled cardiology team gives consultations, screenings, testing, monitoring, and everything in between. We are Nevada's first medical group to provide high-speed molecular cardiac imaging, and the 20th in the world.

Endocrinology: Consultation and treatment for diabetes, thyroid conditions, glandular diseases, and other hormone-producing system disorders in adults courtesy of a team of physicians, nurse practitioners, certified diabetes educators, and registered dietitians. Patients enjoy robust education on managing blood sugar, use of insulin pumps, and individualized medical nutrition therapy.

Gastroenterology: Our Gastroenterology Department specializes in the consultation and care regimen of stomach, colon, intestine, esophageal, and liver disease, as well as Hepatitis C. Outpatient procedures such as colonoscopies, sigmoidoscopies, and endoscopies are also provided.

HIV: Our HIV specialists provide the beginning and ongoing thorough HIV care. Our specialists are affiliated with a non-profit research organization so patients can access the latest treatments.

Home Health Services: Helps patients regain independence and become self-sufficient while healing in their own home. This encompasses Palliative Care, offering support for patients with ongoing illnesses, and Pharmacy & Home Medical Equipment, providing prescriptions and medical equipment in-home. Specific services include physical therapy, ongoing care, wound care, and more, administered by skilled nurses, medical social workers, home health aides, physical therapists, occupational therapists, registered dietitians, and speech therapists, to name a few.

Hospice Care: Hospice care provides an atmosphere of peace, comfort and dignity, usually in the patient's home. It's used when care shifts from treatment for a cure to managing pain and maximizing comfort. This service is available to provide compassionate, individualized end-of-life services to patients and their families, including bereavement and grief support, spiritual counsel, occupational and physical therapy, and visits by a registered nurse supervised by board-certified hospice medical doctors.

Hospitalist Program: Hospitalists are physicians specially trained to make all parts of your hospital care work together. From ordering tests to prescribing medications, they work closely with your personal doctor and hospital staff to make sure you receive seamless care.

Neurology: Our Neurology Department provides consultation for new and chronic neurological disorders that may impact the brain, spinal cord, and nerves. We also offer EEG/EMG diagnostic testing and interpretation.

Outpatient Surgery Centers: Our outpatient surgery centers perform a variety of procedures including diagnostics, orthopedic surgery, general surgery, cataract surgery, colonoscopies and EGD's, podiatric surgery, pain management procedures, and more. Fully accredited by the Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC).

Pain Management: Helping patients cope with severe and constant pain conditions, including cancer. We can also learn the cause of and suggest interventional therapies and help manage prescribed pain medications.

Pediatrics: We offer pediatric care for children from infancy to 18 years of age. This department is at the forefront of the field, encompassing the entire spectrum of child development, including physical, mental, social and emotional. Patients enjoy 20 providers at nine locations, with evening and weekend hours available. Educational opportunities for new fathers and prenatal consults offer important information for parents-to-be.

Pharmacy & Home Medical Equipment: Offering prescriptions, hospital beds, wheelchairs, insulin pumps, ostomy supplies, small volume nebulizers, walkers, canes, infusion (fluids) therapy, oxygen, CPAP devices and more to patients in their homes. Full coordination of care is provided, with care delivered by a team of pharmacists, licensed respiratory therapists and RESNA certified mobility specialists.

Podiatry: Our podiatrists and podiatric hygienists can handle everything from injuries of the foot and ankle to foot care for people with diabetes.

Primary Care for Adults: We offer a more thorough, personalized healthcare experience through our Team Medicine approach. From preventive screenings to labs and prescriptions, our highly-skilled providers work together to make each visit friendly and efficient.

Rheumatology (Joint Care): Treatment for rheumatoid arthritis, lupus, osteoarthritis, bromyalgia, and autoimmune diseases through a full array of services including consultations, tests, specialized treatments, and follow-up care. We can also help with joint, bursa, and tendon injections.



CARE PROGRAMS



Falls Prevention Program: This unique and comprehensive program, called Step by Step, helps older adults be aware of their chances of falling. Our healthcare team assesses older adults for falls, gait, and ability to move, and then provides assistance in the reduction or elimination of risks.

Nail Trimming Services: Full nail trimming services for patients with diabetes, vision problems, or other medical conditions that make toenail care difficult. We're the first medical group in Nevada to have all podiatric hygienists on staff licensed by the Nevada State Board of Podiatry.

Treatment Center: Outpatient infusion treatment in a safe, compassionate environment by skilled registered nurses. Medications and services provided include IVIG, Remicade®, Solumedrol®, Tysabri®, and chemotherapies.

Patient Care Conferences: Primary care providers, hospitalists, case managers, pharmacists, nurses, and other medical care providers—including home health—help to make all parts of your care work together when transitioning out of hospitals and other patient facilities.

Referral Navigator Program: All of our adult medicine locations have referral navigators to assist patients with a smooth transition from the first care visit to the specialist visit, including scheduling the appointment so you don't have to talk with the call center to find out if a referral is approved.

Shared Medical Appointments: Available for individuals of all ages and healthcare needs, shared medical appointments allow providers to get to know patients better, giving the opportunity of a full discussion of healthcare needs, and result in further support from a well-coordinated healthcare team and patients facing similar issues.



E-Visits: If you are a Southwest Medical patient, have Internet service, have been with your provider for at least a year, and have seen a provider within the last year, you can use E-Visit. Send a private, secure communication through the Internet 24/7 and you'll typically get a response within 24 hours. Ideal for non-emergency and non-urgent matters.

Electronic Medical Records: Each of our care centers is virtually paperless. Electronic records chart the patient's health, list prescriptions, and let the provider know of any diagnostic tests needed. This handy service is ready for use any time, day or night, at every Southwest Medical location.

Electronic Prescribing: Southwest Medical was one of the first medical groups in the country to put in place electronic prescribing (eRx). These paperless prescription orders let the doctor know if generic options are on hand and automatically check for conflicting dosages, allergies, and interactions with other medications.

Express Check-In: Bypass the front desk check-in at your doctor's visit by submitting your copay online before the appointment. Print out your confirmation and scan it at the doctor's office—the provider will be notified that you've arrived and are ready to be seen.

Drive-Thru Flu Shot Clinics: Every fall, we host annual flu vaccination clinics throughout southern Nevada, with drive-thru options at many locations. Watch our website for upcoming locations, dates and times. No appointment necessary.

Medicine On The Move: In partnership with Health Plan of Nevada and Sierra Health and Life, this 45-foot state-of-the-art mobile medical center brings adult care, pediatric care, wellness education and appointments to communities in Nevada. Visit MedicineOnTheMoveNV.com to learn more.

My SMA Health OnlineSM: A handy tool providing online access to appointment scheduling for Adult Medicine providers. Referral requests can be submitted by your provider instantly, and you can track the status of your referral online. This tool also enables access to medical records, prescription renewals, and more.

My SMA AppSM: Manage your healthcare right from your mobile phone with our easy-to-use mobile app. Request appointments, review your medical records, view and renew medications, check Urgent Care wait times, find a provider, and much more. Apple users can download the app at the App Store; Android users can find it at Google Play.

NowClinic[®]: This modern take on the house call lets you have a virtual appointment for non-urgent and non-emergency issues, such as pinkeye, UTIs, and allergies. See a Southwest Medical NowClinic provider from the comfort of home through secure webcam, smartphone, or other mobile device. Apple users can download the app at the App Store; Android users can find it at Google Play. *Available 24/7 without an appointment—wait times are typically under 10 minutes*.*

On-Site Lab Services and Quest Laboratories: Through a partnership with Quest Diagnostics, we offer full service clinical laboratories, including complete cytology and surgical pathology services and frozen section diagnosis. Quest laboratories are located in seven Southwest Medical care centers, and each has direct interface to the patient's electronic medical records to ensure results are accurately recorded and communicated. We also provide orders for testing to be completed at other lab buildings, including LabCorp[®].

On-Site Radiology Services: Currently at nine locations, services include general radiology, ultrasound, CAT scans, mammography, DEXAs, fluoroscopy, and IVPs. Our Rancho clinic provides general x-ray services, 24/7, and CAT scans 24 hours a day, Monday through Friday.

Telehealth: Patients with a long-term illness such as heart failure, COPD, diabetes, or high blood pressure can take their vital signs at home. This information is then transmitted to nurses who watch the results and tell the doctor and healthcare team. Participation requires a doctor's referral.

Urgent Care & Convenient Care Home Waiting Room: Check in to one of six Urgent Care locations or seven Convenient Care locations online and wait in the comfort of your home instead of the waiting room. Visit SMALV.COM for wait times. From here you can check in by logging into your My SMA Health online account, choosing a location, and selecting "Waiting Room." First time users will need to set up a My SMA Health Online account.

CONVENIENT & URGENT CARE CENTERS

Southwest Medical offers seven Convenient Care locations and six Urgent Cares throughout the Valley, staffed with a full team of healthcare professionals ready to help you feel better. Just choose your nearest location and walk in. **For both Convenient Care and Urgent Care, you can take advantage of Home Waiting Room**, where you can wait to be seen from the comfort of your own home instead of the waiting room.

Convenient Cares

Choose Convenient Care walk-in clinics for non-urgent and non-emergency service, such as the kind you'd typically see your doctor for.

This includes:

- Diagnostic lab tests
- General health screenings
- Minor wound treatment and repair
- Minor illnesses
- Preventive care and some immunizations
- Blood pressure checks
- Treatment of burns and sprains
- Routine physicals and sports physicals

What to expect:

- No appointment necessary
- Personalized attention
- Extended office hours in some locations
- Great care by familiar faces from the Southwest Medical family
- Paperless electronic records

Urgent Cares

Choose Urgent Care when you have an illness or injury that needs immediate attention, but doesn't require a trip to the emergency room.

This includes:

- Most fractures
- Ear infections
- Colds and other respiratory problems
- Sprains and strains
- Abdominal pain
- Vomiting and diarrhea
- Most cuts
- Most burns
- Back pain

What to expect:

- No appointment necessary
- Shorter wait times than the ER (we make every attempt to have our triage nurse see you in 15 minutes or less)
- Quicker results, with efforts to get your FASTlab results back to you in 15 minutes or less
- Lower co-payments
- Access through extended hours, weekends, or holidays
- On-site digital imaging
- Paperless electronic records
- Access to our Urgent Care Home Waiting Room, where you can check-in to one of six Urgent Cares online and then wait in the comfort of your own home until it's your turn for care


